## Footnotes:

### 1. Finished admission episodes

A finished admission episode (FAE) is the first period of admitted patient care under one consultant within one healthcare provider. FAEs are typically counted against the year or month in which the admission episode finishes, but for this analysis we have used the date the admission began, so e.g. an episode which commenced in December 2022 and was completed in January 2023 would be included in the 2022 count, not 2023. Admissions do not represent the number of patients, as a person may have more than one admission within the period.

### 2. Primary diagnosis

The primary diagnosis is the first of up to 20 (14 from 2002-03 to 2006-07 and 7 prior to 2002-03) diagnosis fields in the Hospital Episode Statistics (HES) data set and provides the main reason why the patient was admitted to hospital.

### 3. ICD-10 coding

T185 - Foreign body in anus and rectum

### 4. Patient Age (STARTAGE\_CALC)

The age of the patient at the point when they were admitted to hospital

### 5. Patient Gender (SEX)

The Person Stated Gender Code. Note that for this analysis those records where SEX is recorded as 'Not Known' (i.e. has not been recorded) and 'Not Specified' (i.e. unable to be classified as either male or female) have been counted together as 'Unknown'.

### 6) Hospital Provider

A provider code is a unique code that identifies an organisation acting as a health care provider (e.g. NHS Trust). NHS Providers set up before October 2020 will typically be categorised with a 3 character code, while NHS providers set up from October 2020 and any independent providers will have a 5 character code.

### 7. Disclosure Control

In order to protect patient confidentiality '\*' appears in the table above for all sub-national breakdowns, where it is possible to calculate a value between 1 and 7 from the data presented. All other sub-national data has been rounded to the nearest 5.

If the national total is between 1 and 7 (inclusive), no sub-national breakdown will be displayed.

If the national total is greater than or equal to 8;

- a. Sub-national counts between 1 and 7 (inclusive) will be displayed as '\*'.
- b. Zeroes will be unchanged.
- c. All other counts will be rounded to the nearest 5.

### 8. Provisional Data

The data are provisional and may be incomplete or contain errors for which no adjustments have yet been made. Counts produced from provisional data are likely to be lower than those generated for the same period in the final data set. This shortfall will be most pronounced in the final month of the latest period, e.g. November from the (month 8) April to November extract. It is also probable that clinical data are not complete, which may in particular affect the last two months of any given period. There may also be errors due to coding inconsistencies that have not yet been investigated and corrected.
